

Happy Birthday, MHT Church!

Our beautiful church was dedicated 106 years ago on July 7, 1918 (the church was completed the prior year on Nov. 11, 1917, but not formally dedicated until July). The high altar was installed and first used on Dec. 8, 1918. The stained glass windows were installed in June of 1920, and a 1,000lb bell was added in 1925 to join the original 1883 bell. We are so blessed that our ancestors left us such a beautiful place in which to offer worship to God together as a parish. We are now called to be good stewards of this gift, which we pray will continue to serve as a faith home for many future generations!


Country Kitchen
