As I complete my first year as your pastor, I am filled with gratitude. First, I am grateful to God for all of His blessings to me and to this parish. I am grateful for His grace and mercy, which never fail! I am grateful to all of you for welcoming me and supporting me in so many ways. I am also grateful for our truly remarkable parish and school staff. We are so very blessed!

Also, thank you to all who donated to this year's **Diocesan Services Appeal**. We had roughly 46 more donors to the DSA this year than last year, which is wonderful! As the former Diocesan Vocations Director, I am very familiar with all of the good works that the DSA helps to fund. Also, thank you to all who contributed to our **Mission Appeal** last weekend for the benefit of the Diocese of Kottapuram, India. Both the DSA and the Mission Appeal help us to remember that we are part of a Catholic—meaning *universal*—Church, and that our care for our brothers and sisters in Christ goes beyond our parish borders. Finally, thank you to all who helped make our high schoolers' trip to the **Steubenville Youth Conference** and children's **Vacation Bible School** possible by your time, talent, and treasure. Investing in our youth's faith formation is the most important thing we can do.

New Fiscal Year

The parish finance council recently approved our fiscal year 2024-2025 budget. I am pleased to report that we are forecasting a slight budget surplus for this upcoming fiscal year. Our weekly collection goal will increase 3% from \$15,385 to \$15,865. Even with all of the needs of our aging parish physical plant, maintaining healthy day-to-day operations also remains vital to the life of our parish.

While the special fundraisers we have can be fun and a way to build community, Sunday collections remain at the heart of keeping our lights on and our bills paid (plus they are much more consistent for budgeting purposes!). Giving our firstfruits back to God is not just about keeping the parish going, but also about living in such a way that shows we believe God is real.

PS—Don't forget, we are still looking for more ushers and Sunday Mass gift bearers!
